APC is just a hundred meters from one of the safest beaches in Melbourne. The new college has formed an alliance with Life Saving Victoria to register every child as a member. APC has implemented a 10-week program that uses the ideal of lifesaving to create leadership, team-building and personal strength.

We're fortunate to be close to the Australian National Academy of Music (ANAM), which nurtures the nation's future classical music stars. ANAM will expose our students to the best classical music in the country and make its brilliant young players available to us as specialist music teachers. An extensive Instrumental Music program operates

at the college in conjunction with this partnership.

Gasworks Park's painters, sculptors, ceramicists, actors and dancers are welcomed into our school. Our students are exposed to artistic creativity in all its forms, and to make this possible we are working with the Park's residents on a number of great ideas; an artist-in residence; and major exhibitions.



OUR MOTTO

LEAD

Learning

Our first responsability is to give our students a firm grounding in literacy and numeracy. Strong emphasis is placed on maths, science, english and humanities. But the fundamentals are just the starting point for a far broader range of subjects and higher order learning.

Like the sciences

When it comes to science we have a great advantage - our specialist science facility. Our students will progress from basic science to the harder, university-entry-focused disciplines of physics and chemistry. We have developed a cutting edge science program that's fun and interesting. This is achieved through experimentation and problem solving in areas like robotics and climate change.

We focus not just on history and geography but literature, poetry, philosophy and drama - reflecting our belief in the importance of the arts to forming well-rounded citizens. Our students therefore will develop a deep understanding of historical and social issues.

Our college has a Select Entry Accelerated Learning (SEAL) Program which allows high potential students to learn at a faster rate and in greater depth. But even if your child is not in SEAL, high standards are expected of every student, and they are expected to pursue their talents and achieve their highest potential.



Albert Park College was chosen as one of just 10 'Apple Schools' in Victoria. This means Apple provides us with technical, training and other crucial support.

So what does being an 'Apple school' mean for students, teachers and parents?

Simplicity

It means substituting a range of purchases with one lightweight device. Their device will replace items like calculators, textbooks and dictionaries. The bulky school bag is replaced with a sleek APC school bag.

Excitement

It makes learning more stimulating. Take a French class. The iPad's French language dictionaries will be able to talk and assist with mastering pronunciation. Using Google Earth, students will be able to navigate their way around Paris boulevards, teleconference with French 'iPad pals', watch French TV, visit the Louvre, and do things previously only possible via Air France.

Using the iPad's drawing and painting software, they can replicate a Monet painting, and with guitar software learn how to play a Francois Hardy tune.



Tradition

Technology won't dictate curriculum. It's a complimentary tool only – so mathematics, science, history and english will remain central. Students will flip digital pages on a screen rather than paper pages in a book.

The future

This means students will be using the touch-screen technologies they will need in their professional and adult lives. Your child will be a scholar with the world of learning at his or her fingertips.
