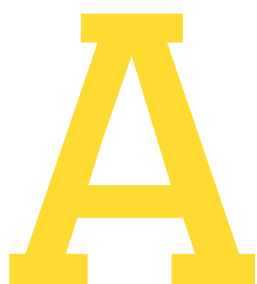
ALBERT PARK COLLEGE BASKETBALL ACADEMY
