



SCHOOL PLACEMENT POLICY

Students at Albert Park College are enrolled in accordance with the statewide placement policy.

Where there are insufficient places for all students who seek entry, students are enrolled in the following priority order:

1. Students for whom the school is the designated neighbourhood school.
2. Students with a sibling at the same permanent address who are attending the school at the same time.
3. Where the Regional Director has restricted the enrolment, students who reside nearest the school.
4. Students seeking enrolment on specific curriculum grounds. Please note that the Select Entry Accelerated Program falls into this category.
5. All other students in order of closeness of their home to the school.
6. In exceptional circumstances, compassionate grounds.

Any appeals by parents/carers against a school decision not to provide a Year 7 placement are:

Considered by the placement committee at the desired school.

Escalated to the Regional Director when they cannot be resolved by the school.
